**AirRadio and BAA Renew Letter of Agreement for Mobile
Communications Services at BAA's UK Airports**

19 January 2009: AirRadio Ltd confirms it has renewed its Letter of Agreement with BAA Airports Ltd extending it to November 2013.

This Agreement for the supply of radio communications at BAA's seven UK airports helps to further expand the community of users on its trunk radio systems already established at each of BAA's airports. It will also provide BAA tenants with the opportunity to maximise the use of data applications for operational purposes at London Heathrow by subscribing to AirRadio's new private digital business radio network – AR-en.

AirRadio's trunk radio systems offer significant benefits over PMR radio, enabling users to make calls between different companies operating across an airport. Radios can be programmed to provide one-to-one, one-to-many and broadcast call capability whilst the system automatically manages congestion issues. High levels of resilience ensure uninterrupted network service. Importantly in the current economic climate, Trunk networks have a flat monthly fee, giving stability to mobile communications costs.

AR-en – the Enhanced Network from AirRadio – is the new digital system deployed to give customers at the world's busiest international airport, Heathrow, resilient and reliable voice and data applications for operational purposes using a private business radio network. Being a private network AR-en provides customers exclusivity of service by not having to compete for access with non-business users.

Steven Inglis, Sales Director for AirRadio, said: "The renewal of this Letter of Agreement with BAA recognises and confirms our position as a leader in mobile communications for the aviation industry. It allows us to offer airport tenants a consistent communications solution across the Authority's UK airports, enabling them to ensure their people and resources work efficiently and cost effectively whilst providing good customer service and maintaining health and safety."
